**Town of Miami Police Chief:** Plans and directs the long-term programs and activities of the Police Department in the enforcement of laws and ordinances and the prevention of crime and protection of life and property. The principal function of an employee in this class is to serve as executive officer to the department with the responsibility of planning and direction all the functions, activities and operations of the Town Police Department. This position is responsible for the protection of lives and property in the Town through the supervision and direction of all police functions. The work is performed under the direct supervision of the Town Manager, but considerable latitude is granted for the exercise of independent judgment and initiative. Supervision is exercised over the work of all police department employees. The principal duties of this position are performed in both a general office environment and an outdoor environment that may include exposure to adverse weather conditions and to potential personal danger. Candidate will work closely with the public and therefore must be skilled in public relations.

**Minimum requirements:** Applicant must have a minimum of eight (8) years of full time experience in law enforcement as a sworn officer, at least five (5) of which must have been at the full supervisory or command level. Must qualify for certification by the AZPOST. Salary is negotiable.
