PUBLIC NOTICE**

**NOTICE OF INTENT TO ESTABLISH FEES FOR THE TOWN OF MIAMI SEPTAGE
RECEIVING STATION
PURSUANT TO A.R.S. § 9-511.01**

The Council of the Town of Miami, Gila County, Arizona, at a public meeting on August 14, 2017, adopted a motion to direct staff to publish a Notice of Intention that the Town of Miami intends to establish rates and fees related to Wastewater Services for receiving sewerage at its septic receiving station.

The Town of Miami intends to establish fees for discharging collected wastes to the Town sewerage system at the Town’s septage receiving station and provides this written notice of the proposed fees pursuant to A.R.S § 9-511.01. The following fees are proposed:

Septage Fees	\$0.08/gallon for COD between 0 and 900 mg/L	Minimum load charge \$90.00	At time of disposal
	\$0.10/gallon for COD between 901 and 9,000 mg/L	Minimum load charge \$90.00	At time of disposal
	\$0.23/gallon for COD between 10,000 and 30,00 mg/L	Minimum load charge \$110.00	At time of disposal
	COD higher than 30,000 mg/L – Special authorization required	Determined by Town on a case-by-case basis	At time of disposal

* “COD” means Chemical Oxygen Demand and is the concentration of the septage being discharged.

The Miami Town Council will consider approving these proposed rates in a Public Hearing during its regular council meeting to be held October 23, 2017 in the Council Chambers, 500 West Sullivan Street, Miami, Arizona 85539. The Council meeting is scheduled to begin at 6:30 p.m.

THE ABOVE FEES WILL BECOME EFFECTIVE THIRTY (30) DAYS AFTER APPROVAL BY THE TOWN COUNCIL.

A copy of the written report and data supporting the fees is available for review by the public in the office of the Town Clerk, 500 W. Sullivan Street, Miami, Arizona, during normal business hours, Monday through Friday, 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. and is posted concurrently with this Notice on the Town's website at miamiaz.gov. Persons wishing to comment on the proposed changes may do so, in writing, prior to the public hearing to be held on the date listed above or may testify in person at the hearing.
