

Town of Miami
Public Hearing Regarding Use of CDBG Funds

The Town intends to apply for approximately \$1,000,000 in FY 2019-2020 CDBG funds from the competitive Colonia account in federal CDBG funds from the Arizona Department of Housing. The CDBG funds must be used to benefit low-income persons and areas, alleviate slum and blight or address urgent need. A public hearing will be held at 6 PM on Monday, June 15th at Miami Town Hall 500 W. Sullivan St. Miami, AZ 85539 to gather citizen input on the use of the CDBG funds. Examples of possible uses include the following:

- 1) Substantial Owner Occupied Housing Rehabilitation
- 2) Public and Privately Owned Water System Improvements;
- 3) Public and Privately Owned Wastewater System Improvements;
- 4) Planning and Capacity Building for future Water, Wastewater or Substantial OOHR Project;

Due to the impacts of the COVID-19 pandemic, which have prompted declarations of a public health emergency at both the state and federal levels, this meeting will be conducted using measures to protect public health.
