**E-P.1 - NOTICE OF PROPOSED PROJECT TO BE LOCATED IN (OR THAT WILL IMPACT ON) A
FLOODPLAIN OR WETLANDS**

The Town of Miami is proposing to conduct a Street Improvements project to be funded using CDBG funds received through the Arizona Department of Housing (ADOH).

The Town of Miami has determined that this proposed project lies in or will impact a floodplain/wetlands and thus is publishing this notice in compliance with Executive Orders 11988 or 11990 and the Floodplain Management Wetlands Protection Guidelines adopted by the Water Resources Council.

This proposed project is located in all or parts of the following streets; Canyon Ave., Nash Ave., Sykes Alley, Miami Ave., Latham Blvd., Loomis Ave., Kent St., and Mill St. The project will consist of Street Improvements, and will involve approximately two (2) acres of floodplain.
