The *Town of Miami* hereinafter referred to as *Town*, through a Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) from the State of Arizona Department of Housing (ADOH), will accept bids from qualified firms or individuals with *an A (A-2, A-3, A-5, A-12, A-14) engineering contracting commercial license* as registered with the Arizona Registrar of Contractors to perform the following services: street, road, drainage, and asphalt paving construction.

**Project Description**

This federally funded project consists of construction of *Street Improvements* as follows:

*Improvement of six street segments in the Town of Miami including: (1) Nash Avenue from Sullivan Street to Sykes Alley; (2) Miami Avenue from Live Oak Street (US-60) to Gibson Street; (3) Latham Boulevard from Live Oak Street (US-60) to the south for approximately 100 feet; (4) Loomis Avenue from Live Oak Street (US-60) to the south for approximately 110 feet; (5) Kent Street from Live Oak Street (US-60) to the south for approximately 170 feet; and (6) Mill Street from Live Oak Street (US-60) to Smelter Street. In addition, optional bids are required for the following two additional street segments: (Bid Option 1) Sykes Alley Drainage Improvements from Keystone Avenue to the east for approximately 160 feet and (Bid Option 2) Canyon Avenue Drainage Improvements from Live Oak Street (US-60) to the south for approximately 200 feet. The proposed improvements include construction of a new Portland Cement concrete street; construction of new curb and gutter sections; milling and asphalt overlay of existing streets; reconstruction of ADA sidewalk curb ramps; installation of drainage catch basins and outlet pipes; construction of a new double chip seal street resurfacing; installation of new concrete valley drain sections; and other associated contingent and miscellaneous items of work.*

**Objective/Scope of Work**

The contractor shall furnish all materials, labor, equipment, services, transportation, and perform all the work for the *Town's* project known as the *Street Improvement Project* for the *Town of Miami*, Arizona as called for in the Specifications and Drawings. The proposer should prepare a detailed time schedule for completion. The successful proposer will be required to lend all possible assistance in the preparation, investigation, and documentation necessary for compliance with all applicable federal Labor Standards/Davis-Bacon and other requirements of ADOH. The successful proposer should be prepared to comply with all local, state, and federal safety and environmental requirements. The project shall be accomplished in accordance with all federal program and state statutory requirements to include 2 CFR 200, Executive Orders and the Arizona Administrative Code.

**Proposals**

To be considered, *one (1) original and two (2) copies* of the proposal must be provided and in accordance with the Instructions to Bidders included in the bid package.

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***Sealed bids will be received in the office of the Town Clerk, Miami Town Hall, 500 W Sullivan St, Miami, AZ 85539 until 2:00 p.m., on Wednesday, September 26th, 2018, at which time all bids received will be opened and the amount of the total bid and alternates read aloud. Failure of the proposer to complete all of the bid documents may result in rejection of the proposal. All bids should be identified as "Sealed Proposal - Street Improvement Project".***

A bid security in the form of a certified check, cashier's check or bid bond in the amount of five percent (5%) of the bid shall accompany each proposal. Bonding companies issuing acceptable bonds in conjunction with this project must hold a certification of authority to transact surety business in Arizona as issued by the Director of the Department of Insurance. All bid security shall be made payable, without condition, to the *Town of Miami*. Said bid security shall be considered liquidated damages and shall be forfeited to the *Town of Miami* in the event the proposal is accepted and the successful bidder fails to execute the contract and furnish the required bonds within ten (10) working days after the notice of bid award.

The *Town* will not conduct a pre-bid conference.

Bidders will not be allowed to withdraw submitted bids during the ninety (90) day period.
