ADONIS AVE & ROSE RD IMPROVEMENT PROJECT CDBG Contract #135-20

The TOWN OF MIAMI hereinafter referred to as Town, through a Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) from the State of Arizona Department of Housing (ADOH), will accept bids from qualified firms or individuals with an A (A-5, A-12, A-14) engineering contracting commercial license as registered with the Arizona Registrar of Contractors to perform the following services: asphalt and concrete street pavement reconstruction, sidewalk reconstruction, full-depth concrete pavement patching, pavement crack filling and sealing, railroad track and miscellaneous removals, trench drain/inlet construction, storm drain installation, and other related improvements.

Project Description

This federally funded project consists of the construction of **street improvements** as follows:

Removal and replacement of asphalt pavement, removal and replacement of concrete pavement, removal and replacement of curb & gutter sections, removal and replacement of sidewalks; construction of a cement treated subgrade, installation of storm drain pipe, construction of a cross-street trench drain, utility fixture adjustments, full-depth concrete pavement patching, pavement, removal of railroad track and miscellaneous items, removal and replacement of traffic signs, traffic control, mobilization, and miscellaneous and contingent items of work; all to make street and drainage improvements on Adonis Avenue and Rose Road for the TOWN OF MIAMI.

Objective/Scope of Work

The contractor shall furnish all materials, labor, equipment, services, hauling, and perform all work for the Town's project known as the ADONIS AVE & ROSE RD IMPROVEMENT PROJECT, CDBG 135-20, for the TOWN OF MIAMI, Arizona, as called for in the Specifications and on the Plans (Construction Drawings). The proposer should prepare a detailed time schedule for completion. The successful proposer will be required to lend all possible assistance in the preparation, investigation, and documentation necessary for compliance with all applicable federal Labor Standards/Davis-Bacon and other requirements of ADOH. The successful proposer should be prepared to comply with all local, state, and federal safety and environmental requirements. The project shall be accomplished in accordance with all federal program and state statutory requirements to include 2 CFR 200, Executive Orders, and the Arizona Administrative Code.

Proposals

To be considered, one (1) original and two (2) copies of the bid proposal package (3 sets total) must be provided in accordance with the Instructions to Bidders included in this bid/contract documents package.

Sealed bids will be received in the office of the Town Clerk, Miami Town Hall, 500 West Sullivan Street, Miami, AZ 85539 until 01:30 p.m., on Wednesday, December 16, 2020, at which time all bids received will be opened and the amount of the total bid and alternates read aloud. Failure of the proposer to complete all of the bid documents may result in rejection of the proposal. All bids should be identified as "SEALED BID PROPOSAL - ADONIS AVE & ROSE RD IMPROVEMENT PROJECT, CDBG #135-20".

A bid security in the form of a certified check, cashier's check or bid bond in the amount of five percent (5%) of the bid shall accompany each proposal. Bonding companies issuing acceptable bonds in conjunction with this project must hold a certification of authority to transact surety business in Arizona as issued by the Director of the Department of Insurance. All bid security shall be made payable, without condition, to the TOWN OF MIAMI. Said bid security shall be considered liquidated damages and shall be forfeited to the TOWN OF MIAMI in the event the proposal is accepted and the successful bidder fails to execute the contract and furnish the required bonds within ten (10) working days after the notice of bid award.

The Town will conduct a non-mandatory **pre-bid conference and site inspection on Wednesday, December 09, 2020, beginning at 09:30 a.m.** A teleconference option can be made available for attendance. Interested bidders should meet at the Miami Town Hall, 500 West Sullivan Street, Miami, AZ 85539 which is accessible to persons with disabilities.
