

# TOWN OF MIAMI NEW TRASH PICKUP GUIDELINES EFFECTIVE SEPTEMBER 1, 2016 (excluding normal garbage pickup)

**Definitions:**

**Garbage:** *wasted or spoiled food and other refuse, as from a kitchen or household.*

**Trash:** *discarded matter; refuse.*

Trash (Bulk) pick up days are by Zone (1 – 4 on the map) (example: Zone 1 – 1<sup>st</sup> Monday, Zone 2 – 2<sup>nd</sup> Monday, etc.) every Monday except holidays, then it will be the next working day. Pick up days included in current charges of \$5.00 on your monthly billing and are included in current regional pick up schedule.

**LAWN/YARD (BULK) (For larger loads that cannot be picked up with regular garbage\*)**

A. Tree limbs, brush must be cut in 4-foot lengths.

**THE PROPERTY OWNER IS RESPONSIBLE FOR MAKING SURE GARBAGE AND TRASH ARE SEPARATED, IF NOT SEPARATED PROPERLY IT WILL NOT BE PICKED UP. THE OWNER WILL BE HELD LIABLE FOR VIOLATIONS.**

\*If needed, you can call the Town Hall to make a special appointment for pick up with one-week notice. There is a \$25.00 pickup charge, plus a \$12.50 charge for half trailer load and a \$25.00 charge for every full trailer load. Loads will not exceed any safety or load limits of the trailer, town employees will ensure safety and load limits are obeyed.

**LARGE GENERAL HOUSEHOLD ITEMS FOR PICKUP ARE BY SPECIAL APPOINTMENT ONLY**

- A. Appliances
- B. Furniture

Pickups are available on Wednesdays with a minimum of one-week notice & there will be a pick up fee of \$25.00 plus a disposal fee ranging from \$5.00 to \$25.00 per item depending on amount of items to be disposed of.

**RULES FOR PLACING ITEMS OUT FOR PICKUP**

Place general household trash in the street, next to the curb in front of your property. Do not place trash materials in any manner that will interfere with or be hazardous to pedestrians or vehicles. All items should be placed away from electrical boxes, cable boxes, mailboxes, poles, water meters and existing landscape. Placing trash outside too early before the collection day has the potential to create a mess and invite animals, in addition to detracting from the aesthetics of the community. **Residents are asked to place their trash out on the curb or alley one calendar day prior to you collection or by 7:00 am on the day of collection.** Resident's are responsible for cleanup of any small debris remaining.

Paint and paint related material (paint, primers, paint removers, varnishes, wood stains, solvents)

Aerosol containers or pressurized tanks (propane or CO<sup>2</sup>)
