WEDNESDAY, JULY 29, 2026, AT 6:30 PM

1. CALL TO ORDER:

Vice Mayor Gonzales called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m.

2. PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE/INVOCATION:

Pledge of Allegiance. Councilmember Medina gave the invocation.

3. ROLL CALL OF COUNCIL MEMBERS:

PRESENT: Vice Mayor Gonzales, Councilmember Medina, Councilmember Moat, Councilmember Reiman, Councilmember Sosh and Councilmember Stewart.

EXCUSED: Mayor Madrid.

STAFF PRESENT: Town Attorney Joe Estes, Town Manager Rivera, Town Clerk Norris and Public Works Director Derhammer.

4. BUSINESS:

A. Information, discussion, and possible action: The Town Council may vote to convene in Executive Session pursuant to A.R.S. § 38-431.03(A)(1) and (3) for discussion and consultation with the Town's attorney regarding matters related to the appointment, performance, duties, responsibilities, and conduct of the Mayor and to receive legal advice regarding related legal and procedural issues.

Councilmember Sosh moved to recess into executive session. The motion was seconded by Councilmember Medina. Vice Mayor Gonzales called for the vote. Vote – Mayor Madrid – excused; Vice Mayor Gonzales – aye; Councilmember Medina – aye; Councilmember Moat – aye; Councilmember Reiman – aye; Councilmember Sosh – aye; and Councilmember Stewart – aye. MOTION PASSED. 6:32 p.m.

Councilmember Sosh moved to return to open session. The motion was seconded by Councilmember Stewart. Vice Mayor Gonzales called for the vote. Vote – Mayor Madrid – excused; Vice Mayor Gonzales – aye; Councilmember Medina – aye; Councilmember Moat – aye; Councilmember Reiman – aye; Councilmember Sosh – aye; and Councilmember Stewart – aye. MOTION PASSED. 7:50 p.m.

B. Information, discussion, and possible action: Discussion and possible action regarding the appointment of the position of Mayor.

Town Attorney Estes explains the Town Council procedure for removal of the Mayor during a term of appointment. Removal requires the submission of a sworn affidavit of at least two members alleging conduct constituting grounds for removal. The affidavits are filed with the Town Clerk. The Mayor shall be entitled to a hearing on demand before the Council, provided such demand is made in writing within two weeks of the filing of the charge. The Mayor has the right for the hearing to be held publicly or in executive session. The Town Clerk shall schedule a Council special meeting for the hearing as soon as possible, provided that notice of such hearing shall be published on the Town's website at least 14 calendar days prior to the meeting. No action taken tonight.

5. ADJOURNMENT:

Councilmember Medina moved to adjourn the meeting. The motion was seconded by Councilmember Sosh. Vice Mayor Gonzales called for the vote. Vote – Mayor Madrid – excused; Vice Mayor Gonzales – aye; Councilmember Medina – aye; Councilmember Moat – aye; Councilmember Reiman – aye; Councilmember Sosh – aye; and Councilmember Stewart – aye. MOTION PASSED.

The meeting adjourned at 7:54 p.m.
